Providing technical and engineering support services to Town departments, the **Infrastructure Manager** will research and prepare technical reports, recommendations, conceptual designs, and short, intermediate and long term capital replacement plans for matters related but not limited to: storm water and wastewater management, roadways and utilities, infrastructure and special projects.

Reporting to the Director of Engineering & Operations, the Infrastructure Manager will also assist with capital project management, the creation of operating budgets, long range capital replacement planning; capital asset management; be responsible for some staff supervision; and serve as a liaison for technical consultants.

Job Duties and Responsibilities:

- Conducts assessments of Town infrastructure by conducting inventory assessments and short, intermediate and long range capital planning;
- Provides advice, recommendations and direction with regard to operational efficiencies and innovative approaches to service delivery;
- Coordinates and liaises with contractors and manages assigned projects;
- Responsible for capital asset management and fleet management;
- Preventative maintenance of facilities and equipment;
- Coordinates with other divisions to develop long-range operational budgets for the Department;
- Develops cost projections, designs, and RFP's for capital projects;
- Responsible for work order management system;
- Manages the Town's solid waste and recycling program. Prepares reports and provides technical support to the Director of Operations.
- Liaises and coordinates the activities of engineering services with other Town departments, Municipalities, Utilities and Government Agencies;
- Plans and schedules the work of technical support for vehicle and equipment maintenance functions:
- Prepares and administers RFP's for the construction and maintenance of Town infrastructure;
- Performs other related duties within the scope and authority of the position, as required.

- Certified, registered or professional designation, diploma or degree in Civil Engineering or Engineering Design Technology, preferably with experience in a municipal setting;
- Project Management Training is beneficial;
- Minimum 3 years experience in professional consulting or in a municipal setting;

- Strong oral and written communication skills;
- Experience in MS Office products and AutoCAD;
