Reporting to the Manager, Infrastructure Planning, you will be accountable for managing and processing development projects; completing complex negotiations with developers and senior approving agencies; determining the value of work under servicing agreements and approving the release of security payments ensuring completion of developer obligations through legal agreements and security management; preparing, monitoring and updating Development Cost Charges and Subdivision Development Control Bylaws; researching and preparing reports and correspondence on land development and municipal engineering issues for departmental, committee and council meetings; preparing and managing the City infrastructure asset management plan; participating in the formulation and implementation of policies and procedures; monitoring, researching and analyzing existing procedures, standards and design criteria; representing the Infrastructure Planning Division on various committees, task forces and in council meetings; and other duties as required.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Completion of a University degree in Civil Engineering or a related discipline, plus a minimum of 5 years of experience in a municipal engineering field, or an equivalent combination of education/training and experience.
- Registration or eligibility for registration as a Professional Engineer with APEGBC.
- Knowledge of the practices and techniques of civil engineering and construction work.
- Knowledge of the relevant policies, rules, legislation, bylaws, regulations and procedures, especially in the land development process.
- Knowledge of municipal infrastructure including water, sewer, drainage, transportation design and construction standards.
- Knowledge of project management in the municipal engineering field.
- Ability to communicate and effectively present ideas and concepts to all levels within the organization.
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with internal and external contacts.
- Ability to problem solve and analyze information in order to make complex technical computations and assessments.
