The Town of Whitecourt is now accepting applications for a Parks and Open Space Maintenance Coordinator. The position reports to the Director of Infrastructure Services and receives input from the Manager of Facilities and Manager of Works to provide a coordinated effort to maintain parks, trail systems, and outside facility infrastructure

Key duties will include:

- Ensure all daily, weekly, and seasonal repairs and maintenance duties to parks, sports fields, and outside facilities are completed.
- Plan and implement all preventative maintenance schedules and functions of outside recreational facilities and parks.
- Responsible for the general appearance and maintenance of all designated park, sport fields, and open spaces.
- Coordinate maintenance plans and schedules with the Community Services Department to ensure facilities are prepared for various user groups and community use.
- Supervise, provide direction, and train staff as required.
- Work closely with the Town of Whitecourt Communities In Bloom Committee and other groups in the development and implementation of Town beautification initiatives.
- Act as a resource to the Health and Safety Committee and other departments on safety related functions, including training and program development.

Qualifications include:

- Education beyond the high school level with major course work in park maintenance, horticulture, turf management, supervision, management, safety, risk management or closely related field is highly desirable.
- A minimum of five years park maintenance experience, and at least two years at a supervisory level would be an asset.
- A valid Class 5 drivers' licence is required.
- Experience with the operation of maintenance equipment is required. Operation of light to medium equipment would be an asset.
- A high level of organizational skills and self-motivation.
- Knowledge of municipal operations, volunteer organizations, and recreation facility operations.
- Ability to work within a flexible schedule.

The Town of Whitecourt is committed to its employees and provides a salary range of \$32.24 to \$34.89 per hour dependent on qualifications and first-rate benefits package. The successful applicant will be required to pass a preemployment physical and criminal record check, and provide a drivers' abstract, prior to being hired.
