

## Arenas & Pools Supervisor Competition No. 04-54/14

The Arenas & Pools Supervisor is responsible for overseeing the scheduling and directing of all personnel engaged in the maintenance operation of the arena and pool facilities. They oversee the maintenance and repairs of each facility and develops, implements and supervises energy management systems, while building preventative maintenance programs. The incumbent is also responsible for developing and monitoring assigned budgets and developing and evaluating the revenue collection procedure in arenas. He/she retains contractors and works with appropriate City departments to meet necessary standards guided in facility maintenance by copy right laws, Fire Marshall act, WorkSafe BC regulations, the Health Act and other government regulations. All maintenance contracts pertaining to arena and recreation facilities will be managed by the Arenas & Pools Supervisor. The incumbent is also responsible for the traditional management responsibilities of hiring, motivating and coaching employees, assessing employee performance, exercising disciplinary action and for dealing with grievances.

The preferred candidate will have:

- 1. Diploma in Recreation, Facilities Management, or Business Administration;
- 2. Thorough knowledge of Pool and Ice facility maintenance;
- 3. Minimum of five years recreation facility experience;
- 4. Minimum of three years management experience in a parks and recreation operations; and
- 5. Valid Class 5 drivers' licence.
