Specific duties include review of permit applications, providing technical information and interpretation of regulatory requirements to internal and external groups. You review applications for building, gas, plumbing and electrical applications, maintain database records and files for those permits, and issue permits when authorized. You will assist with ensuring compliance with the Alberta Building Code and the Land Use Bylaw. This position is ideally suited to a graduate from a recognized post-secondary institute who has a desire to become a certified Safety Codes Officer in the future.

You have a diploma in architectural or building construction technology along with previous office experience, preferably in a municipal setting. Demonstrated excellent interpersonal, organizational, verbal and written communications are necessary. Computer proficiency in MS Office and familiarity with electronic data base management such as Workflow (Laserfiche) is needed, along with proven proficiency with electronic tools, i.e. smart phone, lpad, etc. Possession of a valid Class 5 Alberta driver's license is required.
