Provide effective technical and supervisory leadership in the operation and maintenance of a Class IV Water Pollution Control Plant, sewage pumping stations, forcemains, and the Centennial Fountain. Function as the Corporation's Overall Responsible Operator (ORO) in accordance with Ministry of Environment Regulation 236/11 (OWRA).

Qualifications:

Requires an individual who: has a valid Ontario Class IV Sewage Treatment Systems Operator License acquired by passing licensing exams; Community College diploma in Engineering Technology, specializing in Wastewater Treatment or Environmental Science; has a minimum of four years related experience in operating a Class IV Sewage Treatment Plant in a unionized environment including supervisory experience; and has a valid Class G driving licence. Must possess leadership and team building skills; the ability to effectively coach, motivate, and coordinate the work of others; the ability to function in a computerized environment including a working knowledge of word processing, spreadsheet, finance, and SCADA (Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition) software; the ability to develop and write written reports, policies, and procedures; the ability to support and facilitate positive work relationships in a unionized environment; and good public and employee relations skills. The incumbent must have a creative/innovative focus on service delivery; a commitment to customer service and continuous improvement; a respect for the diversity of opinions, perspectives and ideas; and be comfortable with changing priorities and demands.
