

Position Title: Microsoft SSIS/SSRS Specialist

Position Summary:

The Microsoft SSIS/SSRS Specialist provides systems analysis and design support for the corporate Microsoft SQL data warehouse. This includes developing/testing and implementing SSIS packages to populate existing SSAS data cubes, and develop SSRS reports based on the cubes.

Position Requirements:

The successful candidate will have an understanding of database architecture, applications programming, and network systems along with experience in the IT field developing and maintaining complex SQL databases in a large corporate setting. Must have strong knowledge Microsoft SQL Server Integration Services along with problem solving and critical thinking skills to diagnose problems and determine steps necessary to achieve an effective solution. Must be highly familiar with development and business intelligence tools (Visual Studio, C# (C Sharp), SQL, SQL, ETL, SSRS, .NET, etc.) Must have solid knowledge in business intelligence, ETL, report development and working knowledge of data modeling and analysis.

Key Responsibilities Include:

- Design and develop reporting solutions utilizing SSRS
- Design, develop and maintain SSIS Packages that implement complex ETL processes
- Perform root cause analysis on system/user errors and identify corrective action and liaise with others in the support team to resolve business critical issues
- In addition to the above technical skills and attributes, the candidate must agree with the following statements and provide documentation for the items below.

Independent Contractor

It is understood and agreed that in giving effect to the Contract, neither party shall be or be deemed a partner, agent or employee of the other party for any purpose and that their relationship to each other shall be that of independent contractor. Nothing in the Contract shall constitute a partnership or a joint venture between the parties. Neither party shall have the right to enter into Contracts or pledge the credit of or incur expenses or liabilities on behalf of the other party. Nothing in the Contract shall be construed as to create the relationship of employer and employee

between the County and the Contractor and its employees. The Contractor shall remain solely responsible for all statutory obligations imposed on an employer with respect to any individual providing services pursuant to the Contract.

WSIB

The Contractor shall, within ten (10) days of execution of a written Contract with the County of Simcoe, provide the County with a current WSIB Clearance Certificate. It is the Contractor's responsibility to remain in good standing with WSIB and provide current clearance certificates to the County for the duration of the Contract term.

Professional Liability Insurance

The Contractor is required to provide evidence of Professional Liability insurance coverage with a limit of not less than ONE MILLION DOLLARS (\$1,000,000.00) per claim, where services or activities are professional in nature and thereby excluded under the Commercial General Liability policy.
