Reporting to the Risk Management Program Manager the incumbent is responsible for the administration of claims, including claim response, assessment, defense, settlement negotiation, and the disposing of claims as delegated by the Risk Management Program Manager for the Corporation, the Niagara Police Services Board/Niagara Regional Police Service ("NRP") and Niagara Regional Housing ("NRH").
