STRUCTURAL WORKER 2

This position involves a range of park maintenance activities, related to the maintenance and operation

In this position you will work under the direction of the Park Technician, Operations Coordinator, Superintendent of Structures and the Section Manager to perform manual and semi-skilled tasks involving considerable physical effort in maintaining, renovating and constructing park structures requiring more complexity than the Structural Worker 1.

The Structural Worker will assist senior supervisory staff in maintenance and construction activities, including site layout, applying finishing materials, framing and form work, renovation and refinishing, trouble shooting and park infrastructure deficiency identification.

You will also assist in the renovation and maintenance of playgrounds, water parks, sport courts, youth parks, park buildings, park signage, lighting systems, utility services, bridges and stairs, backstops and fencing, picnic shelters, benches, and other miscellaneous park related structural elements.

The successful candidate will possess the following:

Completion of grade 12, supplemented by one course on **supervision** plus completion of five additional courses from an accredited post-secondary education institution in any of the following course areas:

- Blueprint and plan reading
- Structural materials
- Grading and drainage
- Use of survey equipment
- Landscape construction
- Carpentry
- Park Facility Maintenance Management Inspection
- Certification as a Canadian Certified Playground Inspector, CSA

A minimum of 2 year's experience and training in the maintenance and construction of structures as well as a valid BC Driver's License and sound knowledge of structural materials and procedures, drainage, structural maintenance requirements and inspection is required.

Applicants under consideration will be required to consent to a Police Information Check/Vulnerable Sector Check
