The Town of Kindersley is seeking an enthusiastic and hard-working Public Works Labourer to join our Department of Transportation and Environment. This position is a full-time permanent in-scope position, reporting to the Manager of Public Works.

Duties & Responsibilities

- · Painting street lines, hydrants, and curbs
- Manual labour, mostly outdoors
- Assisting with day to day functions of the department including but not limited to:
 - Street Maintenance, including but not limited to, patching, crack sealing, line marking, and sweeping streets
 - Operation of heavy equipment
 - Traffic Control, including but not limited to, the maintenance of street signs, traffic control signs and traffic signals
 - Drainage, including but not limited to, clearing debris and blockages from catch basins, and removing weeds and debris from ditches
 - Mosquito Control
 - Maintain sewage lagoon, pump house and lift stations in the sewage system
 - · Maintain curb stops, valves and fire hydrants
 - Sidewalk repairs
 - · Parking lot and town yard maintenance

Required Skills and Qualifications

- High School Diploma or G.E.D
- Valid Class 5 Driver's license
- Standard First Aid and CPR/WHIMIS
- Must possess a valid Driver's license
- Be able to work in an independent environment and as part of a team, respecting fellow workers, management, Council, and the general public
- Ability to lift heavy objects, walk and stand for long periods of time and perform strenuous physical labor under adverse field (outdoor) conditions.
