General responsibilities include: developing custom applications and integrations; creating, supporting and optimizing systems routines; and providing technical support and maintenance where required. You will exercise considerable independent judgement and action within the framework of established guidelines and standards.

The incumbent will develop and design applications and web services; customize and support existing applications; write and maintain system administration routines; implement quality control procedures; prepare and maintain documentation; perform analysis and produce reports; maintain systems and data where required and; establish and maintain effective working relationships with internal and external contacts. You will have a good working knowledge of database design principles; object-oriented programming, and application design patterns. You will have a passion for learning, a good sense of humour, and strong communication skills with both a technical and business audience.

The successful candidate must possess application development skills including HTML5/CSS3, JavaScript, and C#.NET. Additionally, you will have experience with REST and SOAP web services, SQL Server and Windows Server administration, and version control systems such as Subversion or Git. Application development experience using ArcGIS, Adobe Flex/AS3, Python, Linux, and MySQL databases is highly desirable.
