He/she will develop a full working knowledge of Town of Okotoks design & construction specifications and all aspects of development and subdivision processes including administration of Construction Completion Certificates and Final Acceptance Certificates.

Specific duties include but are not limited to communicating regularly with contractors and developers' representatives to ensure conformance to design and construction standards; on-site inspection of utility installation projects; preparation of inspection reports, etc.

Candidates must have completed a Civil Engineering Technician Program and have 3 years relevant experience, preferably in a municipal setting. Membership or eligibility for ACET is required.
