Reporting to the Deputy Chief/Manager, Community and Health Services Department, Paramedic and Senior Services Branch, Paramedic Services, is responsible for supervising the direct oversight of the Paramedic Services, Community Paramedicine Programs, including research initiatives, design, expanding Paramedicine in the community, and the use of new medical devices, medical procedures or techniques (e.g. EPIC, CREMS, Atlantic Study, ALPS, ICE PAK Cervical Spine Clearance, Seniors Falls Programs, Bypass programs, Emergency Housing), in compliance with applicable legislation, standards and Regional policies and procedures; scheduling community educational activities, clinical responsibilities, coaching new staff, report writing and data analysis; and supervising community initiatives, peer presentations and establishing new external partnerships.

## Qualifications

- Successful completion of a Community College Diploma in Business Administration, Health Sciences or related field or approved equivalent combination of education and experience achieved through certification as an Advanced Care Paramedic.
- Current certification as an Advanced Care Paramedic in the province of Ontario.
- Minimum three (3) years of progressive experience in a Paramedic Services environment including program administration/delivery, business planning/budget, program development, advanced care paramedic education, research, program design, policy writing and supervisory or leadership experience.
- Health-related instructor qualifications including Heart & Stroke CPR Instructor, Heart & Stroke AED Instructor and certified Standard First Aid Instructor.
- Valid Ontario Class "F" drivers license.
- Satisfactory Police Criminal Background Check.
- Demonstrated knowledge of relevant Regulations, Acts, By-Laws, Standards, guidelines and procedures pertaining to ambulance operations and Incident Command.
- Knowledge of Paramedic training programs and of contemporary adult education principles and practices.
- Knowledge of and demonstrated ability in corporate core competencies including customer service, communication, team work, initiative/self management, accountability, and flexibility/adaptability.
