Reporting to the Senior Development Planner, the Development Technician delivers technical frontline service as an essential part of the development and building approvals process. The Development Technician provides first point of contact service to residents and the development industry which include application intake and screening, technical review, and approvals. Additional responsibilities include: Zoning Compliance, and statistical reporting of permits for monthly reporting.

This position requires a minimum of a Certificate in the Applied Land Use Planning Program from the University of Alberta, along with two years of related experience. A diploma related to Land Use Planning, Geography, Urban Studies from a post-secondary institution or a related discipline is preferred. The successful candidate will have familiarity with land use bylaws and knowledge of the Municipal Government Act. Candidates must have a Class 5 Alberta Driver's license, and will be a member of, or eligible for membership in, the Alberta Development Officers Association. This position requires a high degree of computer literacy including experience and knowledge with Microsoft Office suite. Experience with AutoCAD and GeoMedia software is a definite asset. The ability to prioritize and organize heavy workloads is crucial.
