- Respond to and investigate after-hour complaints and inquiries concerning domestic and wild animals, birds and reptiles
- Attend, investigate and document all dog bites under the Animal Control By-Law and report to the Health Department and OPP as required
- Issue Provincial Offences Notices, and attend court as required
- Issue licenses and orders as required, pursuant to the Animal Control By-Law
- Provide humane and skilled capture, handling and restraint of wild and domestic animals including sick, injured and aggressive animals, both in the shelter and in the community
- Required to operate a Co2 gas box. Must assess and determine when the euthanasia of animals is necessary with the assistance of a medical/veterinary professional as required
- Provide assistance to shelter staff as well as other officers on-call if required
- Upon admittance to the shelter check animals for identification including tattoos, microchips etc.
- Investigate and document Livestock Claims
- Provide assistance to Emergency Services agencies in the handling and restraint of aggressive dogs
- Pickup and removal of injured/ill/dead animals from public and private property and transport to shelter
- Arrange for removal of large animals to appointed pound keeper
- Complete detailed reports on all incidents
- Complete daily vehicle checks and Driver Vehicle Inspection Reports
- Recommend new or changes to Animal Control policies and procedures for review and approval by Senior Staff
- Perform other duties and special projects as assigned
- Be responsible to work in compliance with the Occupational Health and Safety Act and Regulations, the Town of Caledon Occupational Health, Safety and Workplace Violence Policy and Procedures, as well as established industry guidelines
