The **Welder / Automotive Technician** is responsible for completing tasks or assignments related to the welding repairs, fabrication and maintenance and repair of the City of Leduc fleet vehicles and equipment as assigned by the Manager, Fleet Services.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- provides welding repairs and fabrication of parts and accessories to the wide-range of equipment used by the city's departments
- troubleshoots mechanical, electrical, hydraulic and pneumatic issues on various pieces of equipment
- provide training and mentoring to apprentices and co-workers on equipment diagnosis, repair and maintenance
- source/order parts and supplies
- maintain inventory of commonly used shop supplies
- maintenance of shop and yard as identified by supervisor
- regular house cleaning duties related to shop maintenance
