- Work Performed**
- Performs a variety of interior/exterior painting duties on City owned properties, including patching, sanding and plastering of various types of surfaces.
  - Uses hand and power tools and equipment, such as brushes, roller, spray guns, sanders, masks, compressors, ladders and scaffolds, power operated man lift, sandblasting equipment.
  - Prepares and maintains written reports and work records.
  - Requisitions materials as required.
  - Plans, schedules and provides direction to helpers
  - Provides Estimates of products and requisitions materials.
  - May be required to show others how to perform tasks or duties.
  - As assigned, performs related duties which are transient, or of an emergency nature, or which are minor but recurring.

**Qualifications** Successful completion of Grade 12 in the Province of Ontario or equivalent plus successful completion of an apprenticeship as a Branch 1 (Commercial & Residential) and Branch 2 (Industrial Painter and Decorator).
