Reporting to the Director, the Engineering Manager is responsible for the oversight of the County's transportation infrastructure including the evaluation, planning, budgeting and construction of capital assets. The incumbent also undertakes special studies, management and review of utilities, review of development applications and oversight of Department permit processes. The Manager leads and coaches staff and engages internal and external stakeholders. This position is located in Walkerton, Ontario.

- Four year degree in Civil Engineering
- Current Professional Engineer designation
- Five years of prior experience in a rural municipal public works environment, combined with experience directly related to plan review, design, approval of municipal services and transportation engineering
- Supervisory experience with the ability to delegate, set expectations, and monitor progress of all direct reports
- Ability to identify issues and implement creative and strategic solutions to overcome problems
- Proven ability to manage construction projects with various parties, such as architects, project engineers, and landscaping installers
- Experience with development of Asset Management Plans
