Assists operations and maintenance staff in performing tasks such as minor construction, building forms, mixing

concrete, grounds maintenance, brush cutting, channel clearing, etc.

Operates ancillary equipment such as trucks, small tractors, lawnmowers, brush saws, weed eaters.

Operates compressors, pneumatic tools, electrical power tools, chain saws,

Performs site preparation and painting work.

Works in confined spaces and conducts safety monitor duties as required.

Assists in leak and/or other emergency repairs.

Obtains tools and parts from warehouses.

Pickup and delivery from suppliers.

Works in compliance with all District safety policies, procedures and WCB regulations.

REQUIREMENTS:

Grade 12 or equivalent.

Ability to operate power and pneumatic tools.

Mechanical ability and construction aptitude.
