This role is a vital member of the Information Technology team to help the organization improve the quality, accuracy, efficiency and responsiveness of City services and achieve Council's vision for the City "*...to be the Hub of the Fraser Valley.*"

The IT Infrastructure Specialist will be responsible for increasing the in-house IT Infrastructure management and support capacity of the City and aims to address various gaps identified within the current IT Infrastructure team.
