From April to September, the Parks Operations Crew Leader (Spray Park) will operate and maintain the city spray park and oversee a crew of summer staff.

Primary accountabilities include:

Arena Operator

- Supervise operational activities such as ensuring ice quality and directing user groups
- Perform regular ice making with an electric ice resurfacer and power edger
- · Monitor ammonia plant, perform ice maintenance checks and ensure proper operations and safety
- Perform general security of the facilities and ensure the safety and orderly conduct of the public
- Perform day-to-day maintenance duties including cleaning glass partitions, washrooms, dressing rooms,

officials' rooms, player boxes, penalty boxes and public areas within the facility

Parks Operations Crew Leader (Spray Park)

- Act as a crew leader for the spray park zone
- Perform repairs, construction, general maintenance and troubleshooting of the spray park and help to establish preventative maintenance and inspection programs

• Perform daily safety checks on the spray park and ensure park is operating in compliance with standards and procedures
