The work of the Engineering Technician V involves performing civil engineering work at a semi-professional level including project scoping, engaging the services of professional engineering consultant through the request for proposal process, managing the design and delivery of engineering projects from the concept phase through to construction completion; responding to public inquiries; providing technical support to internal construction crews; liaising with/making recommendations to the Engineering of Record regarding design changes; mentoring junior staff and participating in intra or interdepartmental initiatives.
