



Municipal Engineering Technologist

The Infrastructure & Operations Department is accepting applications for a Municipal Engineering Technologist. This is a permanent full-time position, under the supervision of the Director of Engineering Services & Operations. The Municipal Engineering Technologist is responsible for engineering services and project management in the fields of municipal engineering and property development. This position is involved in the project delivery of new and rehabilitation projects. The work is performed in a highly technical environment and requires the knowledge and skill for both office and field practices.

The Municipal Engineering Technologist position needs to have knowledge in many disciplines, such as traffic control, environmental aspects (bank stabilization), asphalt, concrete, deep utilities, shall utilities, drainage patterns, etc. The position requires researching different products and procedures in order to make the best decision for the City.

Successful candidates will ideally have:

- Civil Engineering Technology Diploma, or equivalent achievement from a recognized post secondary institution.
- Computer Aided Design & Drafting skills related to municipal engineering and mapping.
- Experience and knowledge of surveying techniques and operation of survey equipment (Total Station and Automatic Level).
- Strong problem solving skills.
- Strong organizational, scheduling and prioritizing skills.
- Working knowledge of Microsoft Office and ability to use spreadsheet programs.
- Ability to multi-task and work under time sensitive deadlines.
- Ability to work outdoors as needed.
