Scope

The Surrey Fire Service maintains one of the largest Regional Fire Dispatch Centres in British Columbia, servicing Surrey residents and 50 other jurisdictions across British Columbia.

We are looking for candidates who can provide a positive emergency communication experience to our customers and all of the agencies we work with.

As part of a team, you will be working a variety of shifts that include working days, evenings, and graveyards of up to 12 hours on weekdays, weekends, and holidays. You will have open availability for short-term callouts and be available on statutory holidays and at peak times.

Responsibilities

Radio Operators are responsible for receiving and transmitting all fire related emergency, rescue, and medical communications as well as after-hours Public Works for Surrey and its clients, and Bylaws for the City of Surrey.

Our ideal candidates are able to:

- · React quickly, logically, efficiently, and calmly to all emergency situations with professionalism and tact;
- Apply critical thinking and sound judgement to help make decisions quickly and accurately;
- Use sound multi tasking and detail-oriented skills while operating a variety of communication equipment;
- Use strong customer service skills to obtain complete and accurate information;
- Demonstrate the ability to work with others in a team environment;
- Communicate effectively both orally and while using window-based computer programs;
- Operate at a dispatch workstation (standing or sitting) for extended periods of time;

- Strong communication skills with a command of the English language.
- Due to servicing diverse communities, fluency in other language(s) would be considered an asset.
