Key duties include operating the ice resurfer and power tools, performing carpentry and minor plumbing repairs, providing janitorial services, and carrying out mechanical tasks as needed. The Facility Operator II also enforces facility rules and regulations during public events and provides assistance to patrons and user groups throughout the complex.

We offer a positive, supportive, team-based work environment with an emphasis on collaboration. If you have a positive, can-do attitude and a keen sense of humour, you will fit right in.

The ideal candidate must have:

- » Prefer a minimum of three years experience in a maintenance/janitorial environment including experience with plumbing and/or electrical, and preferably in a recreation or educational facility;
- » Have a Refrigeration Safety Awareness Certificate;
- » Basic knowledge of conditioners, water filters, refrigeration and other mechanical equipment and machinery;
- » Ability to operate ice resurface machine, ice edger and other related arena and pool equipment;
- » Have, or be willing and able to obtain BCRPA Pool Operator's Certificate (level II);
- » Have, or be willing and able to obtain the Arena Ice maker's Training Course Certificate.

The wage rate for this position is \$31.07 per hour (2024 rate) plus 14% in lieu of benefits, and upon successful completion of the required probationary period, if eligible, participation in the benefit program.
