RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assist senior staff in the direction, supervision and planning of the crews in construction and maintenance projects.
- Assist crew members in performing duties in maintenance and construction of water systems.
- Prepare work schedules and determine materials and equipment required.
- Ensure safety regulations are being met by the crews.
- Provide guidance and training for the crew and assist senior supervisory staff in evaluating employees.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Completed Grade 12, supplemented by at least 3 full credit courses (accredited by BCIT or another approved technical institution), one of which must be related to supervisory skills and one which must be related to civil engineering.
- Considerable experience in supervision, construction and maintenance operations is required as well as personal computer and software knowledge.
- You must have a valid BC Driver's License with a safe driving record.
- EOCP Level 1 Water Distribution certification in good standing.
- You must have the ability to communicate effectively, understand and effectively carry out oral and written instructions, and have knowledge of applicable safety regulations.
