Responsibilities

As the successful candidate, you will:

- Accurately read water meters across residential, commercial, and industrial properties.
- Record and document water consumption data.
- Perform minor repairs as needed.
- Use non power tools.
- Conduct routine inspections of water meters and meter boxes.
- Identify and report signs of damage, tampering, or malfunction.
- Investigate irregular consumption patterns (e.g., unusually high or low usage).
- Report potential leaks or issues that could lead to revenue loss.
- Engage with the public in a professional and courteous manner.
- Respond to inquiries and address customer concerns related to water usage.
- Support accurate billing and overall water utility operations.
